

Needs integrated, comprehensive, long-term approach, aiming at managing existing populations and preventing new stray dogs with


#### Responsible ownership & Mandatory I&R




- Exchange of good practices on enforcement of Identification and Registration
- Improving communication & cooperation between Member States with regard to pet trade
- Greater exchangeability of data from I&R systems,
- Development of guides/guidelines for I&R, breeding, online pet trade, socialization and transport of pets.
- Improving the use of the TRACES system.

# WHY THE EU LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK SHOULD MAKE BOTH IDENTIFICATION & REGISTRATION MANDATORY?



Working for the EU Platform on Animal Welfare

- Without proper I&R we cannot validate the vaccinations, control and eradicate zoonoses or control animal welfare
- Passport is the ideal document to keep an overview of the health information
- > Central registration reduces risk of fraud
- Responsible breeding and trade of dogs and cats is impossible without the proper I&R



Having a European system (e.g. by European Comission or Europetnet) in place would facilitate crosscheck of national data



Going to full electronic identification and electronic passport containing vaccinations, breeder, owners, DNA, medical dossier etc...



### MANDATORY IDENTIFICATION IN THE UK

6 April 2016 → all dogs over 8 weeks of age have to be identichipped

- The burden and cost to the dog owners must be minimal
- Veterinary professionals and trained people can implant the chip
- Fine for non compliance £500
- Cost for change of owner/address varies (£20)

# **Dovecote Veterinary Hospital Free microchipping initiative**



- Identichip FOC for <u>both</u> cats and dogs
- From February 2014 until the law became effective in April 2016



- Animal care identichip → reliable, month's free insurance
- Information → a letter to local clients, the notice boards and the website 'About my area', Facebook 'Warnings'
- Ads for free microchipping with booster reminders

#### 2.50 euro?

Difficult to know exact cost but generated a lot of good will with the clients
