

Legislation

- ▶ Since 1st September 1998:
 - → Every dog must be identified and registered at least at the age of 8 weeks.
 - → No dog may be sold or given away without identification or registration.
 - → A dog entering Belgium must be registered within 8 days.
 - → Registration in 1 central database.
- ▶ Identification and registration: by veterinarian
- ▶ Registration ≠ ownership




Registration of dogs in Belgium

- ▶ Each year: 160.000 new registrations
 - → 21% non Belgian passport
 - → 13% via Traces





Dogs in Belgium





History

- Legislative measures to reduce the number of dogs and cats in shelters
 - → 1996: Ban on sale of dogs and cats on markets
 - → 1997: Mandatory licence for dogbreeders and traders
 - → 1998: Mandatory identification and registration of dogs
 - → 2004: European Passport for all dogs
 - → 2009: Ban on sale of dogs and cats in pet shops



Mandatory identification and registration of dogs


- ► Challenge: unite different organizations (breeders, shelters):
 - → Each: own registration system with own database
 - → Registration = membership of the organization
- ► Founding of BVIRH/ABIEC (Belgian association for the identification and registration of dogs)
 - → Representatives of dog traders, dog breeders, shelters, veterinarians
 - → 1 central database



Current situation

- ▶ BVIRH /ABIEC: ceased activities.
- Designated company: manages a national register.
- ▶ Funding : sale of official documents > self-sufficient.
- ► Rules (rights and obligations) for all participants (legislation).

Database

- ▶ Registration costs
 - → 12,93 euro, includes updates of the dog/owner data e.g. new address
- New developments
 - → Online registration
 - × 60%
 - → Bulk registration (breeders)
 - → Barcode scanner > software of the veterinarian
 - → Use of the National Registration Number



Database

- Competent Authority
 - → Owner of the data
 - → Access to all information
 - → Controls the project
 - → Meetings with representatives of the different regions (Wallonia, Brussels and Flanders)
 - X Technical topics
 - X Legislative





Importance of I&R

- ► Found dogs > owner
 - → Days dogs in shelter
 - → Europetnet.com
- Information on trade of dogs
 - → Number of dogs
 - → Number of dogs from certain breed e.g. with breeding disorders, most popular breeds
 - → Mortality
 - → Imported dogs (combined with information on Traces)
- ▶ Information for inspecting authorities
 - → e.g. number of dogs, owner's history of a dog
- Breeders without licence
